1. INTRODUCTION

This document aims at describing all installation/uninstall steps for:

- The **PLM Manager** application
- The **Report Designer** application

2. REQUIREMENTS

- **PLM Server** installed

3. LAUNCH INSTALLATION

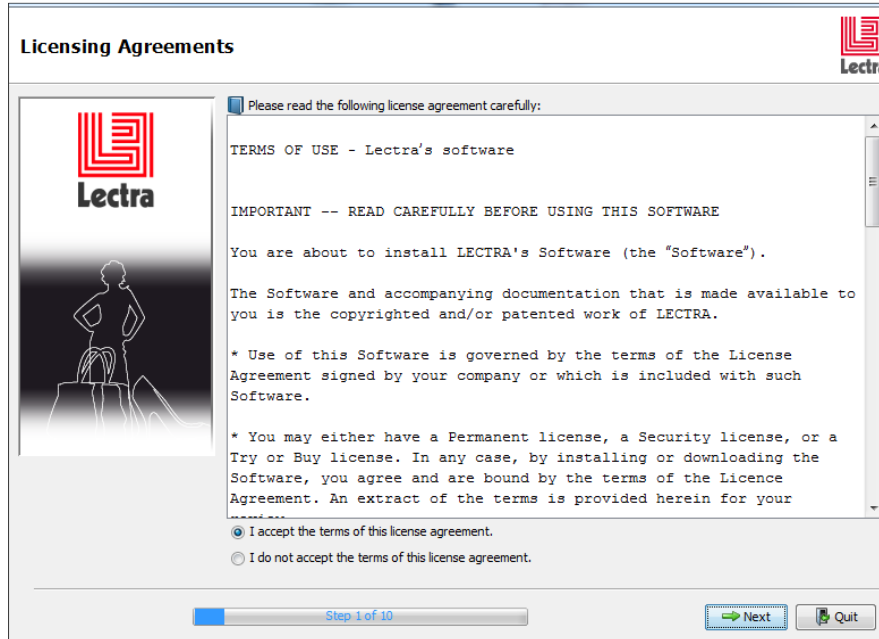
At any stage during the installation, you can cancel the operation by clicking **Quit**.

Navigation between each step is done by clicking the '**next**' and '**previous**' buttons.

- Open **Windows Explorer**
- Browse the directory where *plmmanager-installer* is saved
- Double-click *plmmanager-installer-x_x_x_x.exe*

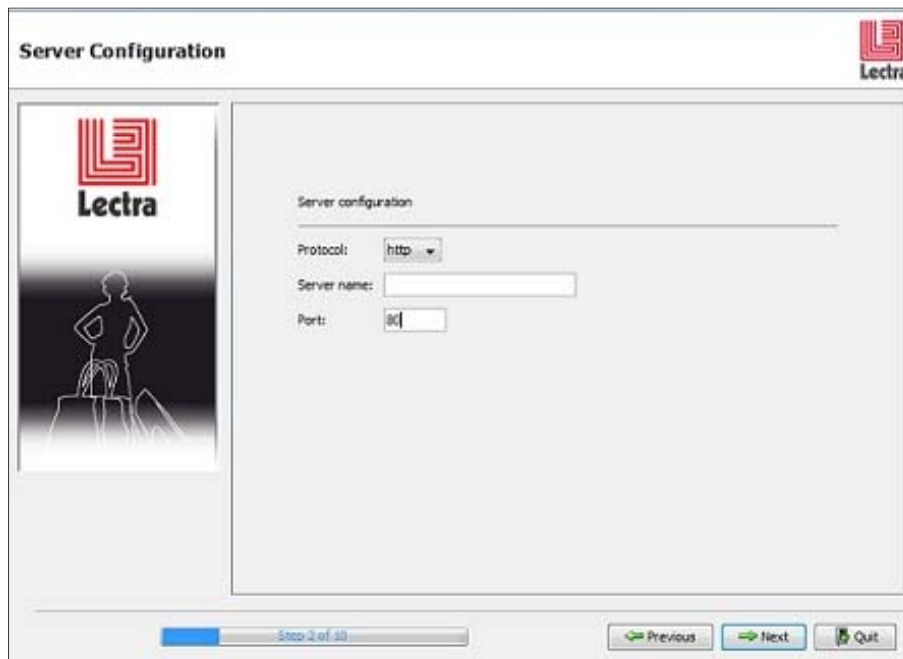
4. LICENSING AGREEMENTS

- When the installer is launched, **accept** the licensing agreements
- Click **Next**



5. SERVER CONFIGURATION

- Enter the **PLM Server** properties
 - **Protocol:** The communication protocol used with the **PLM Server**. The default is *HTTP*.
 - **Server Name:** PLM Server name
 - **Server Port:** Server HTTP port. The default port is *80*.
- Click **Next**

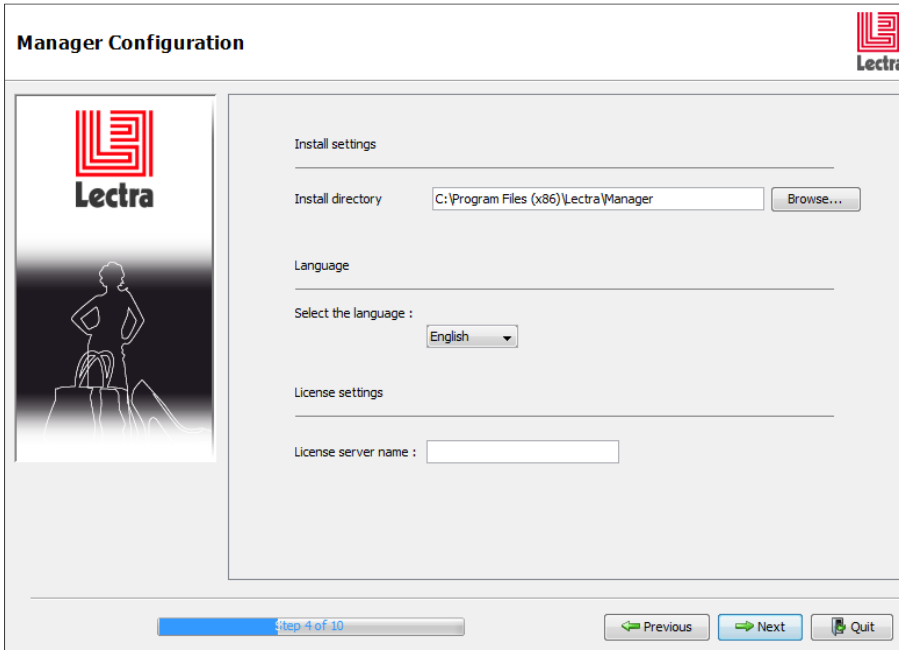

6. PLM MANAGER CONFIGURATION

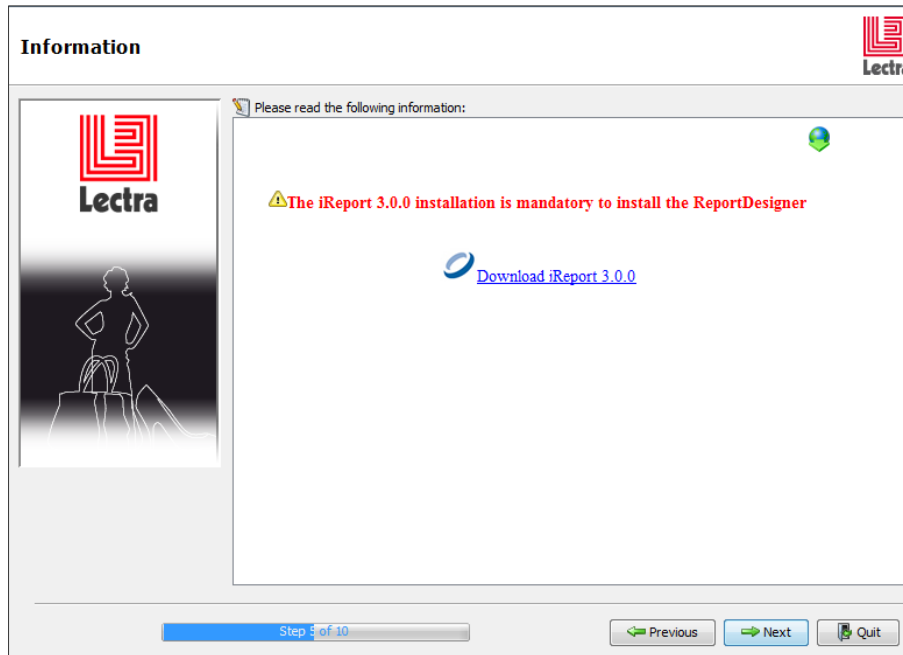
- Set the **PLM Manager** configuration
 - **Install Directory:** select the directory you want to install the **PLM Manager**
 - **Language:** select the language for the **PLM Manager** application
 - **License Server:** enter the license server name
- Click **Next**



7. DOWNLOAD IREPORT

Only if **IReport** has not been installed in the computer or it has not been installed in the default installation directory.

- Download **IReport 3.0.0** by clicking the link and installing
- Click **Next**

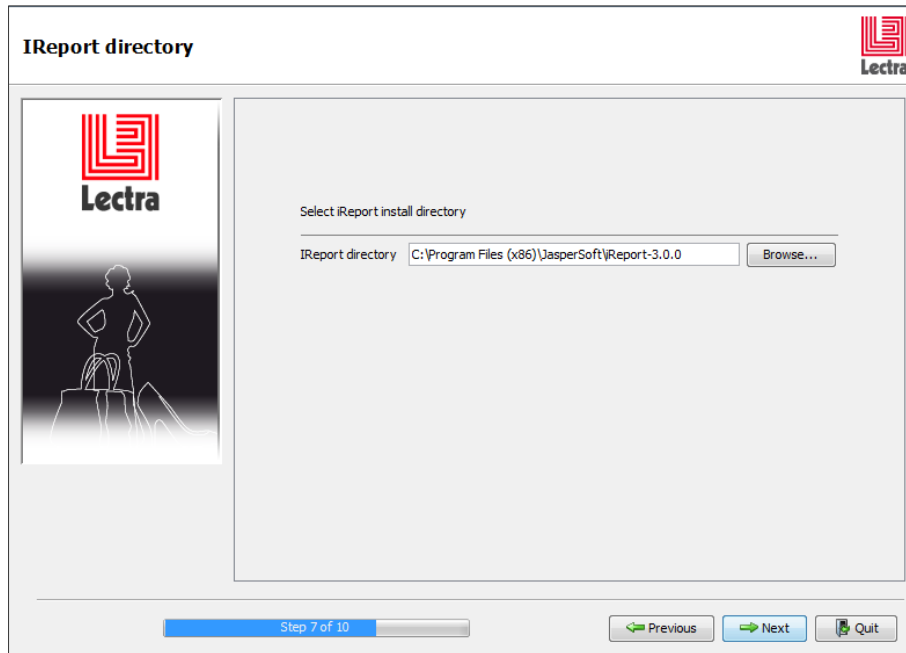


- After the **IReport** install, **DO NOT LAUNCH IT**

8. IREPORT DIRECTORY

Only if **iReport** has not been installed in the computer or it has not been installed in the default installation directory.

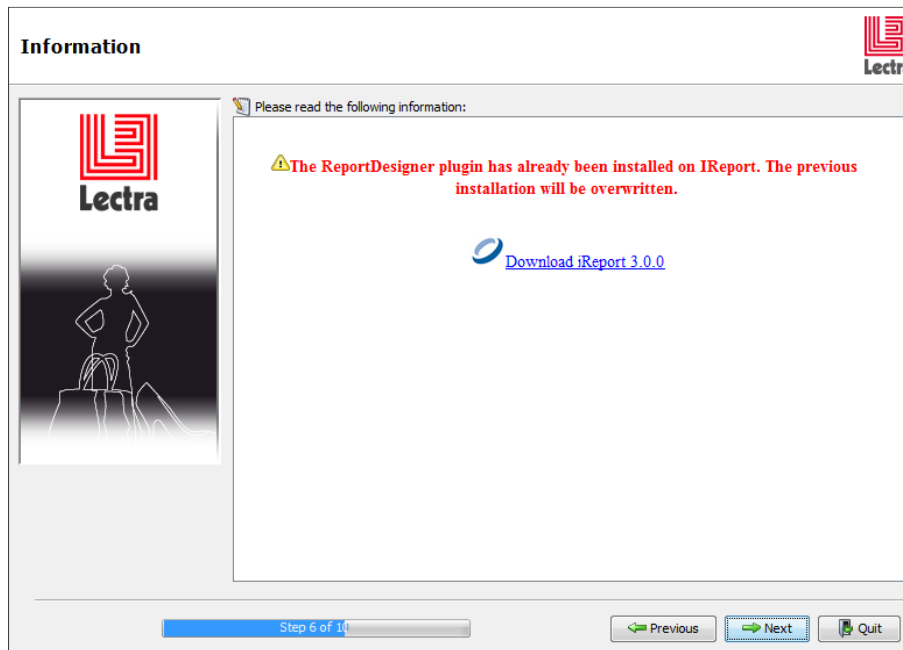
- Set the **iReport** install directory
- Click **Next**



9. REPORT DESIGNER INSTALLATION WARNING

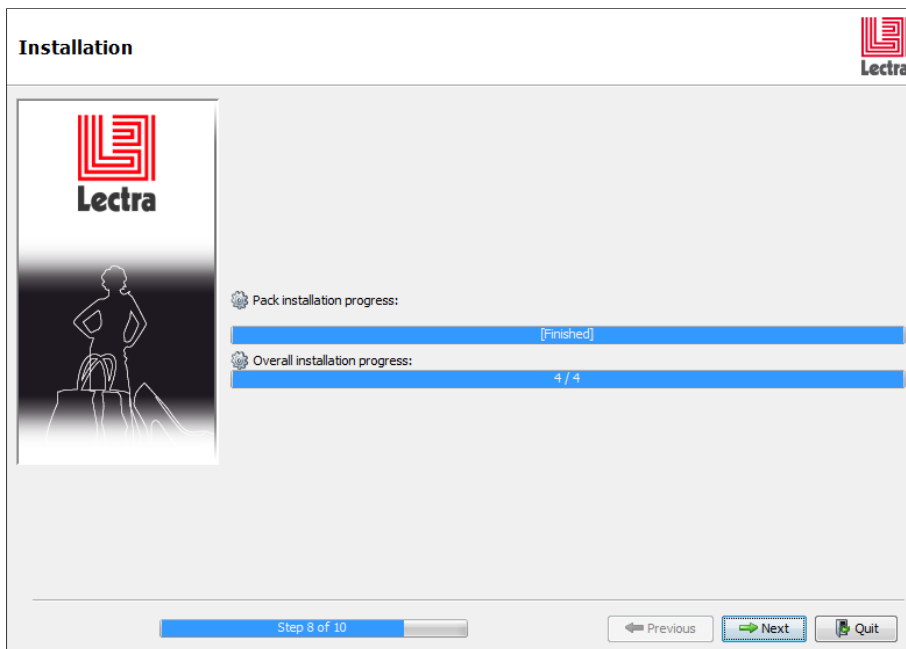
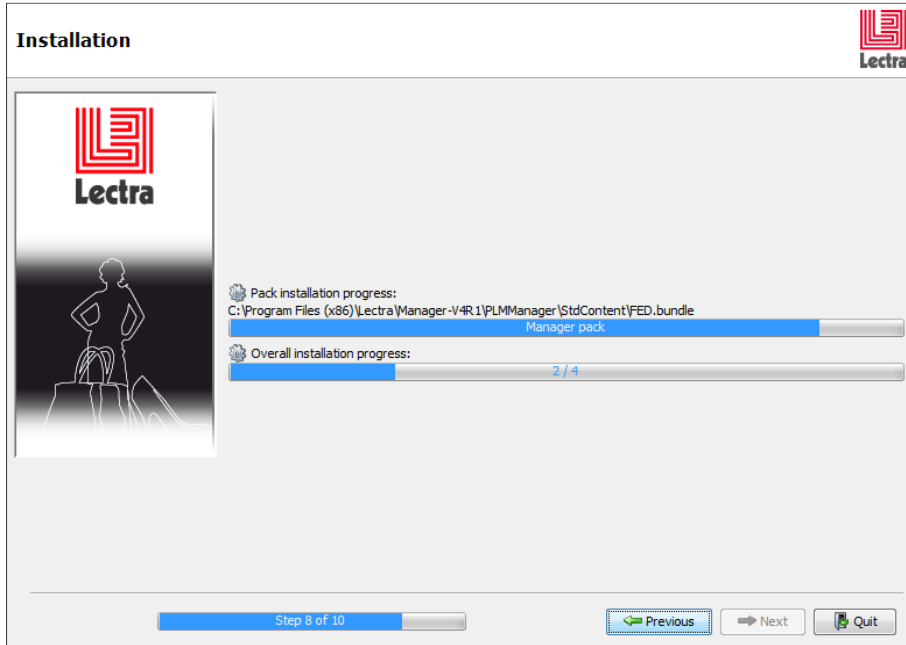
If **IReport** has been installed in the default installation directory, the **ReportDesigner Plugin** will be updated.

- Click **Next** to overwrite the **Report Designer Plugin** installation



10. INSTALLATION IN PROGRESS

- The installation is in progress
- Click **Next** at the end of the installation

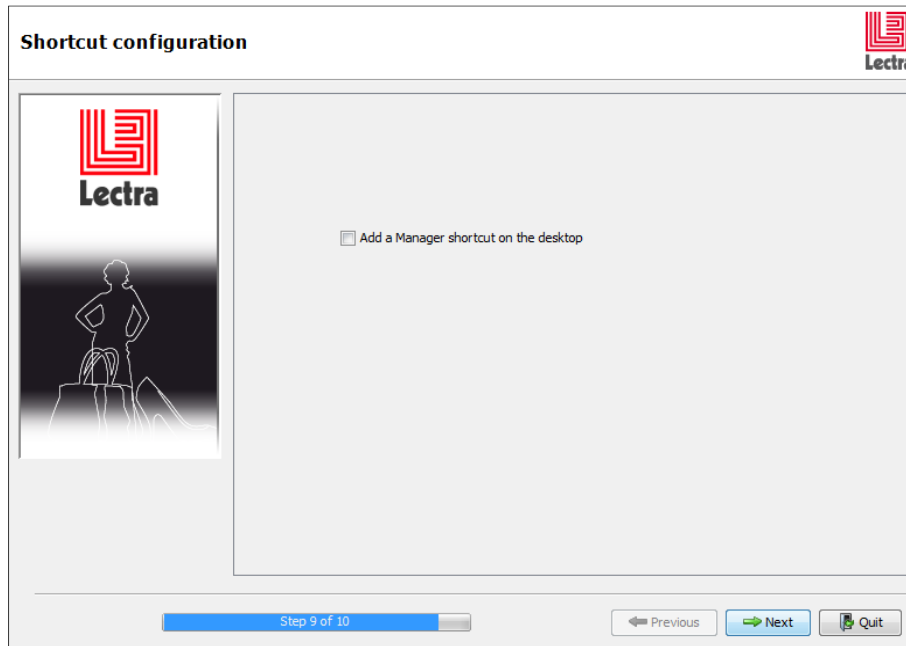


11. PLM MANAGER SHORTCUTS

The **PLM Manager** installer adds automatically an application shortcut in the application group **Lectra\PLM Manager** for all users.

The user can also add a desktop shortcut on all users desktop:

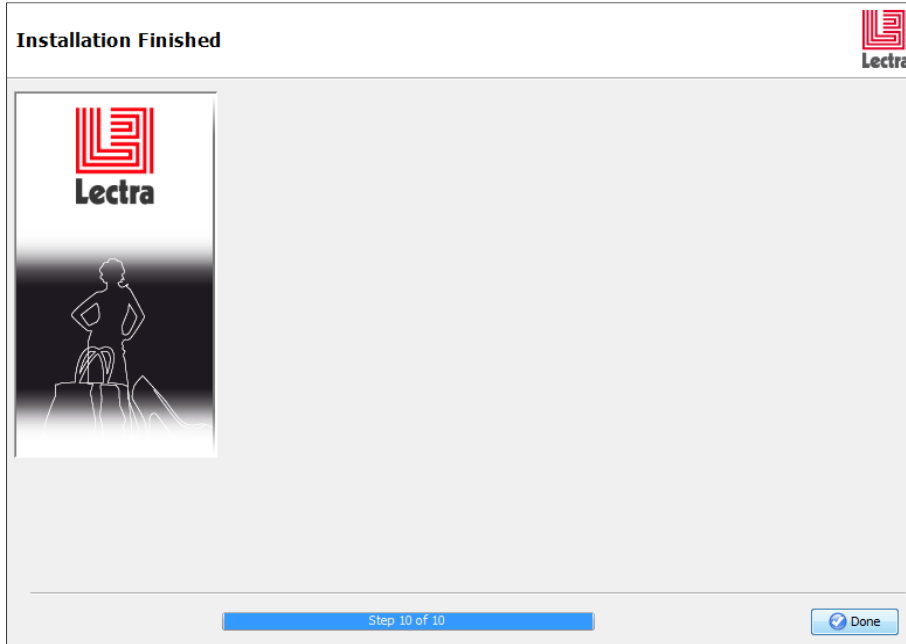
- Click the checkbox to add a **PLM Manager** desktop shortcut for all users





12. END OF INSTALLATION

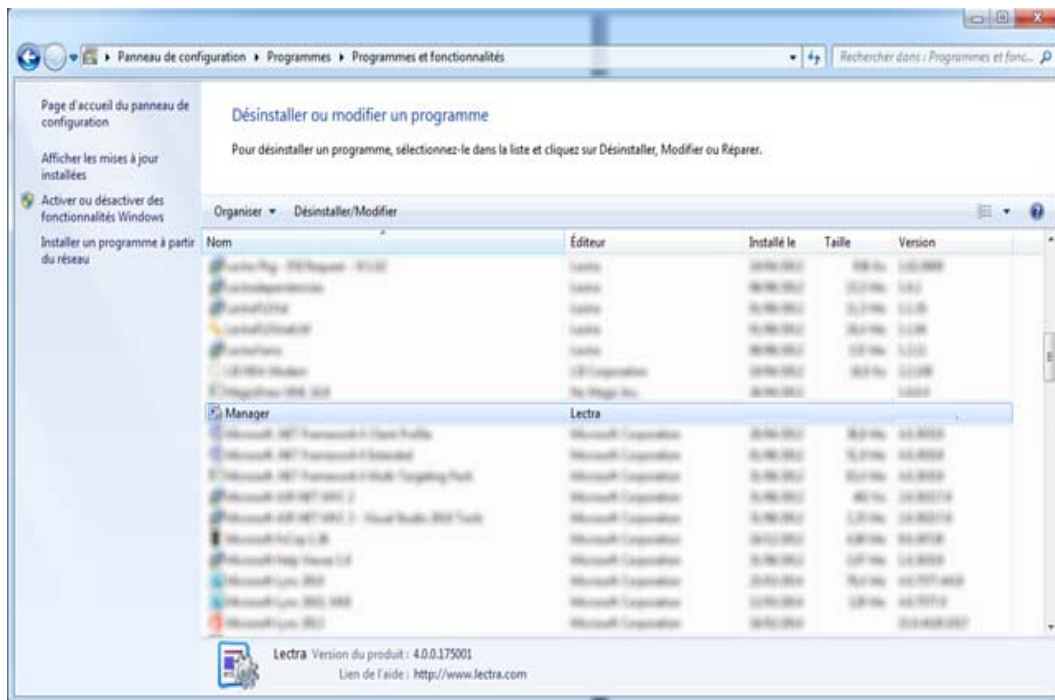
The **PLM Manager** and **Report Designer** applications have been correctly installed.



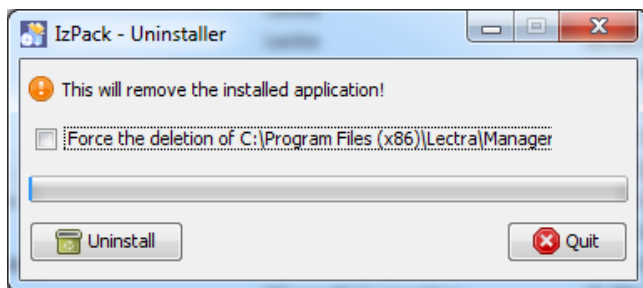
13. UNINSTALLER

Once it has been correctly installed, the application sets up an uninstall program.

This one is accessible via the Windows's start menu, or via the **Control Panel** then **Programs and Features**.



When the uninstaller is launched, it asks you to set up only one option (it forces the deletion of the main folder).



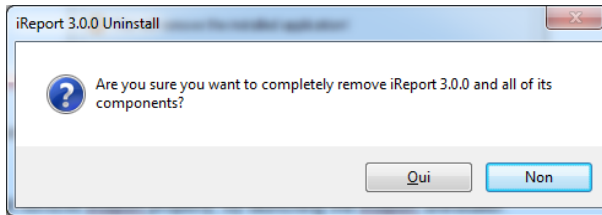
Two buttons allow you to start the **uninstall** or to **quit**.

Uninstalling iReport

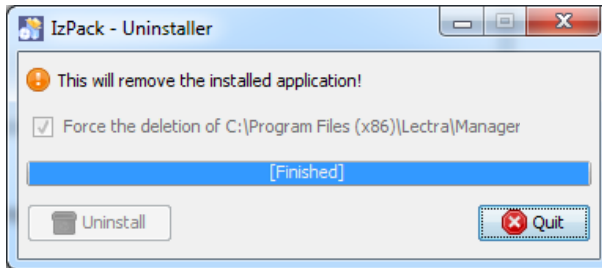
During the uninstall, the uninstaller will ask you if you want to uninstall **iReport** too.

Launching the **iReport** uninstaller will completely remove **iReport**.

Be careful, this will completely uninstall **iReport**, not just the **Report Plugin** installed.



Once the uninstall is completed, you just have to click the **Quit** button.



WARNING: Even after you have uninstalled the application, the main installation folder remains in place. This is because the uninstaller uses the JRE subfolder which cannot be removed.

The existing main folder causes no problem. However if you want to delete it, you can do so once the uninstall is completed.
